



Massachusetts Law Regarding Unemployment Claims

Effective January 1, 2004 Massachusetts law changed as follows:

Effective this date, a Temporary Employee of a Temporary Agency shall be deemed to have voluntarily quit employment if the temporary Employee does not contact the Temporary Help Firm for reassignment before filing for benefits, and, unemployment benefits may be denied for failure to do so.

It is recommended that you contact your Daley and Associates recruiter for reassignment before filing for unemployment.
